

Nomination Package for Students Interested in Serving on the UNBC Senate

Included in this application package are the following forms:

1) Nomination form for Senate:

The nomination form must be completed by all students who wish to serve on the Senate, as these are elected positions. If there are more nominations received than there are positions available, an election will be held in which all eligible members of the student societies are permitted to vote.

2) Application form for Senate* Committees:

This form must be completed by any student seeking nomination to SENATE*, as all Senators are required to sit on at least one Senate committee, providing there are available vacancies. Those seeking to serve as a student representative on a Senate committee without sitting on the full Senate may also complete this form.

Student Nomination Form to Serve in ELECTED Positions on the UNBC Senate

Eligibility to Serve on the UNBC Senate:

In accordance with the UNBC Senate Handbook, and the *University Act* of British Columbia, in order to serve in an elected position on the UNBC Senate, the following criteria must be met:

- (i) Be a student as defined in 3 (m) (i), and
- (ii) Be a student in good standing (a student who is in "good standing" is a student who is not on academic probation, and
- (iii) Be an undergraduate student registered in at least one course in the semester in which a vacancy arises and have been registered in the semester immediately preceding the one in which the vacancy arises. Registration in the May semester is not a requirement to meet this condition provided that, if the vacancy arises during the May or September semesters, the student is registered for the September semester and was registered during the preceding January semester, or
- (iv) Be registered in a co-op work term in the semester in which a vacancy arises, or
- (v) Be a graduate student who is currently enrolled in a program leading to a graduate degree.

Students elected to the Senate or to Senate Committees shall be eligible to serve during the May semester even though they may not be enrolled in any credit courses.

There are **eleven student representatives on Senate**. Positions will include at least one student from each faculty, two undergraduate students, elected at large and two graduate students, elected at large. Two positions are also reserved for the Presidents of the Northern Undergraduate Student Society and the Northern British Columbia Graduate Student Society

Procedures:

- 1. Complete the nomination form on the back of this page.
- 2. Submit your nomination form to a Governance Officer.
- 3. Your eligibility to serve in an elected position will be verified by the Office of University Governance.
- 4. The Office of University Governance will conduct an election, if necessary (an election will be necessary when the number of nominations received is greater than the number of positions available). In order to serve on the UNBC Senate student members must be elected by the membership of the student societies.
- 5. If an election is not required, the candidate(s) will be declared "elected by acclamation," and their name(s) will be submitted to Senate for information.
- 6. All nominees will be advised of the outcome of elections by the Office of University Governance.
